

SABAH SURVEYORS BOARD
CPD POINTS ACCREDITATION

In an effort to ensure that all licensed surveyors are practising lifelong learning to enhance their professional knowledge, skills and practices, Sabah Surveyors Board at its 156th Meeting held on 3 June 2019 had decided to implement the CPD points accreditation as one of the conditions to enable respective surveyors who have accumulated the minimum CPD credit points to be eligible for renewal of their licences for the following year.

CPD POINTS REQUIREMENTS

The categories of CPD credit points requirements are as follows:

Category	Mandatory CPD points for issuance of annual licence to practice
Licensed Surveyors age below 70 years	10 CPD Points
Licensed Surveyors age 70 years and below 75 years	5 CPD Points
Licensed Surveyors age 75 years and above	Exempted from CPD Points requirement
Special Cases	Discretion of the Board to consider granting exemption

QUALIFYING CPD EVENTS AND CREDIT POINTS

The qualifying CPD Events and the maximum credit points allowed for each event are listed in **APPENDIX A**.

EXCESS CPD CREDIT POINTS

Licensed Surveyor who has accumulated more than 10 CPD credit points during a calendar year may carry forward a maximum of 5 CPD credit points to the following year.

INSUFFICIENT CREDIT POINTS

Licensed Surveyor who has not achieved the required 10 CPD credit points, it will be up to the Board to decide on his eligibility to be issued with annual licence.

SUBMISSION OF CPD RECORDS

Licensed Surveyor shall submit a CPD log book (**Annexure B**) with all the supporting documents to the Board together with the application for renewal of annual licence.

DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION

The CPD Points requirements will be mandatory with effect from 1 July 2019.
